

# FM dial

As an ever growing and expanding radio ministry, we at KNGN continually look forward into the future for opportunities to better reach the world with the Gospel of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Over the past several decades, we've diligently carried the Word over the AM radio waves at 1360 Mhz. Over the past 5 years, we've been broadcasting via the internet to all corners of the globe. Now we have been gifted the almost inconceivable opportunity to seek after the ability to spread the Good News over the FM radio waves!

KNGN Radio is now officially beginning the incredibly large, complicated, and cumbersome task of raising funds, creating a construction and operation plan, building and upgrading facilities, updating logistics and functional capabilities, and carrying out the generally huge list of tasks needed to build and operate of a full power FM radio station. For those that might not know, this isn't KNGN's first try at moving toward the FM dial. Only a few years back, we sought after a non-commercial license won from the FCC by an unprecedented point system. We subsequently lost in gaining the Construction permit, and moved on in our regular operations of AM and Online radio.

Now, once again, we have been provided a seed by which we can begin seeking after the funds to build a distinctly LCMS Radio station, owned and operated by KNGN Radio and broadcasting to a much wider audience locally, and hopefully someday, nationally!

Beyond the substantial boost in listenership, the credibility an FM Station provides, and the general stability a grouping of radio stations allows, owning a Full Power FM Station will allow KNGN to begin applying for translator FM stations across the Midwest and the entire United States.

As the days wear on and the world crumbles around us, it is essential now, more than ever, to get the TRUTH of the Gospel out to all peoples wherever they are. What better way to preach the word, and teach it's truth than over the radio waves where it can be heard? FM Radio is still widely used, considerably more than AM, and will allow us to carry our signal to places we never imagined before. This expansion would allow us to fill the void of solid Christian programming that exists in the USA today, and bring the light to an otherwise dark world.

Greetings in the Name of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ,



KNGN, over the last few months has had a significant drop in giving, causing us to drop into the "red zone" financially. We still have the finances to continue for many more months, however we need help to remain afloat in the long term.

Ultimately, if the money runs out, the only independently owned and operated LCMS high power radio station in the USA would cease to be able to broadcast, create, produce, distribute, and develop LCMS programming. And the help we offer to LCMS low power FM stations, LCMS radio programs, LCMS churches, and other LCMS organizations would cease to exist. This network is fairly extensive, so it would leave a massive void in the already empty domain of LCMS Instructional Radio, and leave a lot of people in the lurch in their ministries.
